Camp week is spent preparing a biblically based musical which is presented the last evening of camp. The preparation for the musical includes: set/prop design and construction, acting and singing. The Christian theme for the week is also supported and enhanced through many activities such as: morning watch, faithfulness time, evening campfires and secret pals.

We have scheduled recreational activities daily which includes swimming, soccer, and other organized games! There is also a craft center where campers can use their creativity to make things for themselves and others.
